Remembering Peggy Van....by Betsy Gray



Bath High School Preservation's Esther Peggy Elaine Daw: Class of 1975 July 31, 1957~ December 18, 2022

is intriguing because it is a book that does not mention God, miracles, or angels. It is the story of a woman who had a purpose and that purpose was to save the Jewish people. I find so

many similarities between Peggy and Esther.

Peggy was faithful, courageous, and heroic through preserving a school in a historic town until her last few days of life. Why did this matter to her? She stated in the second edition Cookbook that she published, OF PIRATES and PEOPLE, "When we rewrite our history, we risk losing important connections that inform future generations. I hope we can preserve the story of BHS for our families, *community, and future.*" Her heart wanted to save Bath High School just as Esther's heart was to save the Jewish people-even if it meant to "GET HER HEAD CUT OFF!"

Through all the obstacles and challenges she brought together the Beaufort County Board of Education, Beaufort County Commissioners, the Town of Bath, and Bath High School alumni to form Bath High School Preservation in 2005 with 1975 classmates *Mike Godley* and Betsy Gray. This brought us all to a crossroads to preserve our alma mater in the Historic Town of Bath.

The story of Esther in the Bible indeed Through all of these efforts, she was still able to excel while she worked as the Nurse Support Program II (NSP II) Grant Administrator of the University of Maryland securing \$96 million for the State of Maryland in 2020. In 2019, the National League of Nursing (NLN) Certification Board of Commissioners recognized and awarded the very first award to Dr. Peggy Daw since she had lead a state initiative between the Maryland Council of Nursing Deans and Directors and the Maryland Higher Education Commission Nurse Support Program II to develop a new faculty program to facilitate new and maintenance of certification. The Nurse Support Program II developed the Academic Nurse Educator Certification (ANEC) Award.

> In October of 2021 she was inducted in the American Academy of Nursing and also received in October 2021 the State of Maryland Governor's Citation. She was an exemplar of how one's dedication can often make the difference for many.

I silently and deeply knew Peggy's biggest and greatest challenge was dealing with the unknown outcome of her health and leaving behind her beloved family, friends, and pet. From my childhood classmate and friend, I will always remember her modesty, humility, and gratefulness and how she never forgot to tell you " thank you ." Her teachable spirit and authenticity will long be remembered even after the wrecking ball was aimed at the OLD BATH HIGH SCHOOL.
